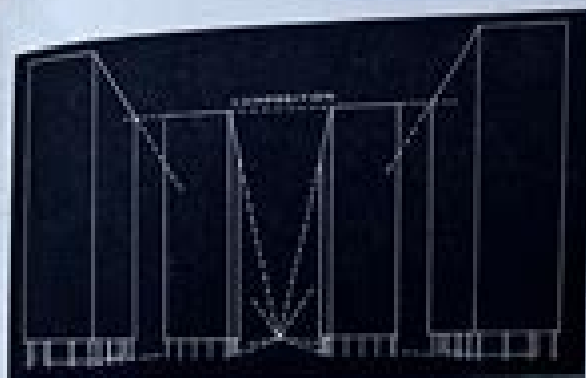


Engineering or architecture? The style of Skyscrapers like the Skyscraper in Chicago, composed of repeated elements, might be called engineering. The architect's line in their composition, which gives them a form and an individual quality.

It is just as ridiculous to think of the personality of a machine. Every machine is born, lives, produces, expends itself, and dies.

The work of architecture, if it is a work of art, is original (in the sense of "giving origin") and does not tolerate any ready-made elements from the outside (prefabrication). That which already exists, the pre-existent, is of no use to it, is foreign to it. Whatever concerns the work must be reformulated so that it will have its own style and unity and coherence.

It is the first Mies van der Rohe building I designed since 1927 which I could be considered an architect (for example, he should achieve unity). This building nevertheless remained a work of engineering because of the possibility of changing its dimensions



(as was demonstrated later). Contrarily, the second and adjacent building, which was altered a great deal because of building regulations and a change in program on the ground floor, belongs more to architecture (notwithstanding this) because its taller wing solves an architectural problem of dimensional illusion with the other, larger building.

I think that many modern buildings that are attributed to architecture (even by me in the past) belong instead, with high honor, to engineering.

It is not easy to establish a real boundary line between engineering and architecture (it may not even be possible: it is a characteristic of exactness that many things are not exact). It is not easy because in some of their solutions expressions the two disciplines meet. There are, moreover, engineers who are great architects and architects who are great engineers; these are engineers who have taught a great deal to architects, and vice versa. This is not, of course, a matter of academic degrees but of the value of individual men, and here degrees do not count.
