The inhibition of a single molecule or signaling pathway by SSMTT frequently results in a hyperactive compensation of other cancer related molecules and signaling pathways as well as the subsequent development of drug resistance Therefore identifying multi targeted therapies i e drugs that are able to target multiple cancer related genes proteins or signaling pathways is a more promising way to success in developing new cancer therapeutics Natural products especially those from traditional Chinese medicine and folk remedies in other countries are an extraordinarily important source for new drug discovery over the past decades Of note

many natural products have often been demonstrated to target several crucial genes or proteins in cancer related signaling networks and exert synergistic effects For example Japonicone A a dimeric sesquiterpenoid from the medicinal plant Inula japonica has been found to inhibit tumor growth and metastasis by dually targeting the TNF NF B and p53 MDM2 signaling pathways Traditionally researchers have believed that the multi targeting mechanisms of natural products have limited their use in cancer treatment due to the low specificity and potential side effects. The growing interest in developing multi targeted cancer therapies may provide another golden opportunity to develop natural products as new cancer therapeutics Nevertheless critical investigations for a comprehensive understanding of the molecular mechanisms of natural products also mean more challenges Our long term goals are to fully understand the molecular targets and mechanisms of action of anticancer natural products and develop them as novel cancer preventive and therapeutic agents.
