1. Georgia - Geographic Region

- 2. Woodland Period: B.C. horticulture became more important to middle georgians instead of crops that became established during early and began clearing forest for fields, more become important in late.
- 3. Mississippian Period (Chiefdoms): a human social organization with rankings, elites or commoners
- 4. Mothers for Colonization, Founding first colony, buffer zone to protect SC, France, FL.
- 5. James Oglethorpe (1496-1766): founded GA, came led by Trustees

6. New-English Colonies

- 7. War of Jenkins' Ear: GA perceived as English colony; boundary of GA FL set; battle of bloody march took place which forced Spanish back across board to FL.
- 8. Colonial Economy (Wine): GA first export crop
- 9. Revolutionary War in Georgia: (war for independence); slavery begins, stamp act, debt based around the world as Lexington started war
- 10. Slavery in Georgia: only British American colony to ban slavery

11. Post-Revolutionary Economy: cotton gin allowed it to flourish

- 12. Alexander Rutledge (1754-1800): GA legislator, founded UGA, initiator, educational progress.
- 13. Taxes-Land Fraud: Marbury sold territories to AL and MS to political leaders for cheap.
- 14. Land Lottery System: public lands in the southern state were dispersed to small yeoman farmers.
- 15. John Ross (1790-1866): fought against removing Cherokee from NC.
- 16. John Ridge is: 1802-1829: first native American senator
- 17. Worcester v Georgia: court struck down GA extension laws, whites weren't supposed to stay in Cherokee territory without permission from the state, Worcester was arrested for doing this and argues that this law was unconstitutional, later GA law was struck down and ruled Cherokee a separate sovereign nation and the previous law was against the constitution... led to removal of Cherokee
- 18. Cherokee Removal: removed Cherokee to OK, leading to trail of tears
- 19. Georgia and Secession: seceded from union in 1861 and created GA 1st new constitution
- 20. Joseph E. Brown: 1 of the most successful politicians in history
- 21. Howell Cobb (1815-1886): Politician
- 22. Alexander Stephens: VP of confederacy built what confederacy speech: Black isn't equal and proslavery
- 23. Robert Toombs: senator said south would never let fed government be controlled by Repub party: led to fight the secession, founding father of confederacy, writer of confederate constitution.
- 24. Atlanta Campaign: battles, Sherman tried to take Atlanta (railroad hub, out) and eventually ATL fell, became end of American civil war; assure Lincoln reelection.
- 25. Sherman's March to the Sea: most destructive campaign against a civilian population during the Civil War; gave no confederate that government couldn't protect from invaders
