Section 6 contains chapters on therapeutic approaches to psychological distress related to complex childhood trauma, dialectical behaviour therapy for borderline personality disorder, racially open dialectical behaviour for over-controlled presentations, and schema therapy. Each of the chapters on clinical problems explains how to assess and treat the condition in an evidence-based way, with reference to case material.
