

HOW TO USE QUOTES IN AN ESSAY

DEFINITION

Using quotes in an essay involves properly citing the source of the quote. This can be done through in-text citations or by including a reference page at the end of the essay. Quotes should be used to support or expand on ideas in the essay and should be introduced and explained to provide context for the reader.

EXAMPLE

"According to John Smith, 'the most important factor in achieving success is hard work' " (Smith, 2020, p.25) or
"The concept of 'the American dream' has been discussed by many scholars, with James Truslow Adams famously defining it as 'that dream of a land in which life should be better and richer and fuller for everyone' " (Adams, 1931, p.18) It's also important to explain the significance of the quote, so the reader can understand the context.
