1 CHARGE YOUR HEADSET

Charge your headset's battery for 2 hours.

1 Plug the Motorola charger into the end of the headset.

The indicator light will glow when the battery is charging. It may take up to 1 minute for the indicator light to turn on when the Motorola headset is fully charged about 2 hours. The indicator light turns green.

2 Disconnect the charger.

Note: Headset is not connected with charging.

2 START BLUETOOTH FEATURE

Your Phone

The phone's Bluetooth feature is off by default. To use your headset, you must turn on the Bluetooth feature on your phone.

For most Motorola phones, go to the main screen.

1 Press **Home**, **Settings**, **Location**, **Bluetooth** tab, **On**.

2 Touch **Phone**.

3 Touch **Change**.

4 Touch **On**.

5 Press **Done** to turn on the Bluetooth feature. The Bluetooth feature remains on until you turn the feature off.

3 PAIR

Your Headset and Phone

Before you can use your headset, you must get them to work with your phone.

Step 4: Enable Headset in Bluetooth Mode

Place on headset by pressing the headset button to enable auto pairing. After a short moment, the indicator light will be steadily lit in blue to indicate headset is in pairing mode.



If the headset does not enter pairing mode, see **TROUBLESHOOTING** for help.

Step 5: Set Your Phone to Look for Your Headset

For most Motorola phones:

1 On your Motorola phone, press **Home**, **Settings**, **Location**, **Bluetooth** tab, **On**, **Settings**, **Look for devices**.

The phone lists Bluetooth devices it finds.

2 Touch **Motorola H710**.

3 Touch **OK** to **Yes** to pair your headset with your phone.

4 Enter the pairing code: **0000**.

5 Touch **OK**.

When your headset successfully pairs with your phone, the indicator light flashes white quickly.

Note: Some steps are for most Motorola phones. For other phones, see your phone's user guide.

4 TEST AND USE

Your phone and headset are now paired and ready to make and receive calls. To confirm they are working properly, make a call.

1 Place the headset over your ear.

2 On the phone, use the number you want to call and press **SEND** key on your phone.

3 If your phone and headset are successfully paired, you will hear ringing on the headset.

After you have successfully paired your phone and headset, you don't need to repeat these steps. For safety, ensure that your headset is turned **OFF** and that your phone is in Bluetooth battery saving mode.

To save battery power, turn **OFF** the headset when you don't use it for an extended time by closing the headset.

USING A SECOND PHONE?

Your headset allows a simultaneous, dual-point connection to two Bluetooth phones.

To pair a second phone to your headset, follow these steps:

1 Turn off any phones already paired with your headset.

2 Turn off your headset to charge the headset battery.

3 Perform Step 2 ("Start Bluetooth Feature"), Step 3 ("Pair"), and Step 4 ("Pair with phone") to pair your headset with your second phone.

4 To connect to both phones, turn on the phone.

5 Open the headset button and then connect it. The headset automatically connects to both phones.

TIPS FOR USING HEADSET WITH TWO PHONES

Use the following tips when operating the headset while connected to two phones:

- The most recently paired phone connected to the headset is always the primary phone. The other phone is listed for secondary phone.
- Incoming calls can be answered from both phones. When answering a call, the other phone is disconnected from the headset. When the call ends, connection to the phone is automatically reestablished.
- Since that calls can be made from either phone, use different key strokes to select which phone to make a call or end the "hangup" call for device.
- Receiving a text call from the number on the phone with the last outgoing call.

TROUBLESHOOTING

My headset will not enter pairing mode.

Make sure that the headset properly paired with the headset and turned **OFF**. If the indicator light is flashing in blue, but not off, the other device may have paired with the headset before. The indicator light becomes steady in a blue following the headset is now in pairing mode.

My phone doesn't find my headset.

Make sure the indicator light on your headset is on. It is a must and check when your phone is searching for devices near it.

My headset worked before but now it's not working.

Make sure your phone is on and the Bluetooth feature is turned on in your phone's user guide. If the Bluetooth feature was turned off or not turned on this temporarily, you may need to repeat the Bluetooth feature steps. Turn **OFF** and pair your phone and headset again from Step 5.
