Procedures and Observations Part I. HOMOLOGOUS STRUCTURES

- Carefully examine the drawings of the bones shown in Figures 1 on the next page. Look for similarities among the various animals.
 - a. Color each part of the human arm a different color. (All bones of the wrist should be a <u>single color</u>, the bone groups of the hand should be a different <u>single color</u>.) Then color the corresponding bone in each of the other animals the same color as the human bone.
 - b. Describe the function of each set of bones below:
