

POLICE OFFICER BIOGRAPHY EXAMPLES

Officer Keane Reeves has been serving the ninth district of the city of Warhol in the state of Georgia for over ten years. He was first inspired to become a police officer after witnessing two officers beating a suspect that they had just arrested, simply out of spite for having caught him. Officer Reeves was just a child at the time, but he vowed to become a police officer that would be able to reshape the department and bring true justice. His biggest inspiration was his mother, who encouraged him to be a protector of the people, rather than protecting himself from the people.

A graduate of Percy High School in Warhol, Officer Reeves is a native to Georgia and the Warhol area. After graduating high school, Officer Reeves obtained an associate's degree in Paralegal Studies from Roanoke County Community College. He worked for two years as an assistant to a criminal lawyer, hoping to gain knowledge about the legal system. He left his position in 2004, disturbed at the amount of injustice he had observed in his work. He joined the ninth district city police later that year, and demonstrated himself to be a calm and fair officer who was trusted by the community.

In 2015, he was promoted to Deputy, and he began to make changes in the structure of the police department. He implemented the use of body cameras for all officers, and insisted on accompanying a random officer each night on making rounds across the city. During his tenure as deputy, the number of complaints received about police conduct have dropped by half. Officer Reeves is currently working on an outreach mission to unite the community and police officers in informal discussions, in order to restore trust in law enforcement over recent tensions in the community.

Race, Crime, and Policing in the Jim Crow South Brandon T. Jett, 2021-07-07 Winner of the Florida Book Award general nonfiction category Throughout the Jim Crow era southern police departments played a vital role in the maintenance of white supremacy. Police targeted African Americans through an array of actions including violent interactions unjust arrests and the enforcement of segregation laws and customs. Scholars have devoted much attention to law enforcement's use of aggression and brutality as a means of maintaining African American subordination. While these interpretations are vital to the broader understanding of police and minority relations Black citizens have often come off as powerless in their encounters with law enforcement. Brandon T. Jett's *Race Crime and Policing in the Jim Crow South* by contrast reveals previously unrecognized efforts by African Americans to use manage and exploit policing. In the process Jett exposes a much more complex relationship suggesting that while violence or the threat of violence shaped police and minority relations it did not define all interactions. Black residents of southern cities repeatedly complained about violent policing strategies and law enforcement's seeming lack of interest in crimes committed against African Americans. These criticisms notwithstanding Blacks also voiced a desire for the police to become more involved in their communities to reduce the seemingly intractable problem of crime much of which resulted from racial discrimination and other structural factors related to Jim Crow. Although the actions of the police were problematic African Americans nonetheless believed that law enforcement could play a role in reducing crime in their communities. During the first half of the twentieth century Black citizens repeatedly demanded better policing and engaged in behaviors designed to extract services from law enforcement officers in Black neighborhoods as part of a broader strategy to make their communities safer. By examining the myriad ways in which African Americans influenced the police to serve the interests of

the Black community Jett adds a new layer to our understanding of race relations in the urban South in the Jim Crow era and contributes to current debates around the relationship between the police and minorities in the United States *Police Detectives in History, 1750-1950* Clive Emsley, 2017-09-29 While the history of the uniformed police has prompted considerable research the historical study of police detectives has been largely neglected confined for the most part to a chapter or a brief mention in books dealing with the development of the police in general The collection redresses this imbalance Investigating themes central to the history of detection such as the inchoate distinction between criminals and detectives the professionalisation of detective work and the establishment of colonial police forces the book provides a the first detailed examination of detectives as an occupational group with a distinct occupational culture Essays discuss the complex relationship between official and private law enforcers and examine the ways in which the FBI in the U S A and the Gestapo in Nazi Germany operated as instruments of state power The dynamic interaction between the fictional and the real life image of the detective is also explored Expanding on themes and approaches introduced in recent academic research of police history the comparative studies included in this collection provide new insights into the development of both plain clothes policing and law enforcement in general illuminating the historical importance of bureaucratic and administrative changes that occurred within the state system **Combating London's Criminal Class** Matthew Bach, 2020-07-09 The criminal class was seen as a violent immoral and dissolute sub section of Victorian London s population Making their living through crime and openly hostile to society the lives of these criminals were characterised by drunkenness theft and brutality This book explores whether this criminal class did indeed truly exist and the effectiveness of measures brought against it Tracing the notion of the criminal class from as early as the 16th century this book questions whether this sub section of society did indeed exist Bach discusses how unease of London s notorious rookeries the frenzy of media attention and a word deleted here panic among the general public enforced and encouraged the fear of the criminal class and perpetuated state efforts of social control Using the Habitual Criminals Bills this book explores how and why this legislation was introduced to deal with repeat offenders and assesses how successful its repressive measures were Demonstrating how the Metropolitan Police Force and London s Magistrates were not always willing tools of the British state this book uses court records and private correspondence to reveal how inconsistent and unsuccessful many of these measures and punishments were and calls into question the notion that the state gained control over recidivists in this period The Politics of Biography in Africa Anaïs Angelo, 2021-08-31 Bringing together historians political scientists and literary analysts this volume shows how biographical narratives can shed light on alternative little known or under researched aspects of state power in African politics Part 1 shows how biographical narratives breathe new life into subjects who upon decolonization had been reduced to silence women workers and radical politicians The contributors analyze the complex relationship between biographical narratives and power questioning either the power of biographical codes peculiar to western colonial origins or the power to

Cowboy Capitalist Charles van Onselen, 2018-04-20 The Jameson Raid was a pivotal moment in the history of South Africa linking events from the Anglo Boer War to the declaration of the Union of South Africa in 1910 For more than a century the failed revolution has been interpreted through the lens of British imperialism with responsibility laid at the feet of Cecil Rhodes Yet the raid was less a serious attempt to overthrow a Boer government than a wild adventure with transnational roots in American filibustering In *The Cowboy Capitalist* renowned South African historian Charles van Onselen challenges a historiography of over 120 years locating the raid in American rather than British history and forcing us to rethink the histories of at least three nations Through a close look at the little remembered figure of John Hays Hammond a confidant of both Rhodes and Jameson he discovers the American Old West on the South African Highveld This radical reinterpretation challenges the commonly held belief that the Jameson Raid was quintessentially British and in doing so drives splinters into our understanding of events as far forward as South Africa's critical 1948 general election with which the foundations of Grand Apartheid were laid

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
