It is generally thought that Dickens originally intended *The Old Curiosity Shop* as a short story like the others that had appeared in *Master Humphrey's Clock* but after a few chapters decided to extend it into a novel. Master Humphrey appears as the first person narrator in the first three chapters of *The Old Curiosity Shop* but then disappears stating "And now that I have carried this history so far in my own character and introduced these personages to the reader I shall for the convenience of the narrative detach myself from its further course and leave those who have prominent and necessary parts in it to speak and act for themselves."
