- Create a short (one line) message explaining why you have selected your position
- Tell your audience a need of the school
- · Give them a brief solution
- Explain why you are the best for the position
- · Create a slogan to help people remember you

- Keep it brief
- Be positive
- Don't slam opponents
- Don't scream
- Don't offer bribes or freebies
- · Don't make promises you cannot keep
- Have fun
