writer's memory of course in a less than pedantic way of the development history of Brisbane in the recent decades as witnessed by the writer over the years. Looking back an account of the embryonic growth of Brisbane is particularly lively and informative from the perspective of an ordinary resident ever since living through his boyhood and growing up in this wonderful city. There are many model displays of various scale for readers to visualize the scenes mentioned in the chapters and to capture readers' attention on some history events places to arouse their interest from a historical perspective.
