1. What is Homeostasis?

The circulatory system is a system of blood vessels that transport blood throughout the body. It is made up of the heart, which pumps blood, and the blood vessels, which carry blood to and from the rest of the body.

7. What are the main types of blood? What kinds of blood are there?

There are two main types of blood: oxygenated blood and deoxygenated blood. Oxygenated blood is rich in oxygen and is carried by red blood cells. Deoxygenated blood is low in oxygen and is carried by white blood cells.

8. What is the main function of the circulatory system? What kinds of blood are there?

The digestive system is a system of organs that break down food into nutrients that the body can use. The main parts of the digestive system are the mouth, esophagus, stomach, small intestine, and large intestine.
