In 1936 Leopold Fischer 1901-1975 in exile from Nazi Germany arrived in California where he created a small but distinct oeuvre of mostly domestic architecture. In contrast to his famous peers Rudolph Schindler and Richard Neutra immigrants whose Southern California buildings are frequently examined and who like Fischer studied with the modernist architect Adolf Loos Fischer and his California structures have until now escaped the attention of architectural history. Exiled in L.A. examines Fischer's important yet overlooked contributions to Southern California architecture. As the whereabouts of Fischer's archives remain unknown Volker M. Welter grounds the designer's California works in comparison

with his pre exile projects and the compositions of fellow architects in California In the 1920s Fischer created experimental working class housing estates in Germany that pioneered ecological construction and living practices Comparable to their predecessors Fischer s California buildings revolve around the functioning the organization of a home as he defined domestic architecture in 1926 Featuring new photography and detailed architectural plans this book is an original contribution to the literature on Southern California s built heritage Private Landscapes Pamela Burton,Marie Botnick,2002 When we think of the gardens of Southern California we tend to think of the enormous semiarid landscapes of the Huntington and Rancho Los Alamitos often built on the sprawling grounds of former ranches But there is another garden tradition in Southern California the modest rectangular suburban plots designed by the most famous architects of mid century modernism Richard Neutra Rudolph Schindler Gregory Ain Raphael Soriano Harwell Hamilton Harris A Quincy Jones and John Lautner These architects saw the garden as an outdoor extension of the space of the houses they designed rather than a neo Spanish fantasy to be added later by a landscapist Their modern gardens made use of low maintenance drought resistant plants and made room for informal outdoor living by children and adults with an emphasis on recreation and exercise The first book of its kind Private Landscapes profiles twenty significant gardens and their accompanying houses by these celebrated architects Using contemporary photographs by Julius Shulman and newly commissioned color images along with plans and plant lists Private Landscapes provides a never before seen look at these gardens As beautiful and practical now as they were 50 years ago these designs continue to provide inspiration for gardeners and designers everywhere Barton Myers Jocelyn Gibbs,Kris Miller-Fisher,Charles Warner Oakley,Luis Hoyos,Howard Shubert,Bruce Robertson,Natalie Shivers,2019-07-05 Drawing on the vast archival resources of its Architecture and Design Collection the UCSB Art Design Architecture Museum University of California Santa Barbara presents an assessment of 50 years of design by Barton Myers b 1934 beginning with his work in the Toronto firm A J Diamond and Barton Myers 1967 1975 to his own offices in Toronto and Los Angeles Barton Myers Associates 1975 present Myers s strongest architectural ideas come out of the planning strategies of his early neighborhood activism in 1970s Toronto his grounding in history and his training in the classical traditions of site and space planning Barton Myers is an avowed urbanist a self described radical in his early advocacy of old fashioned qualities like density mixed use of new and repurposed materials and contextual planning in the late 1960s when that fundamentally conservative position was considered counter culture Myers urban manifesto was codified in Vacant Lottery the title of the Design Quarterly issue co edited by Myers and Canadian architect and educator George Baird in 1978 and which led to a renewal of interest in urban planning and offered a strategy for increasing population densities within cities while preserving the existing residential fabric The term lived on long past the journal s circulation cycle as both an urban infill strategy and an acknowledgment of the ceding of city planning responsibility to the lottery of private developers Myers s design practice has thus always been a social justice practice as well Myers is also a brilliant designer of residential houses that take

advantage of local landscape contexts and adaptive reuse of building materials including steel and glass Five essays on urban planning civic structures reuse of historic buildings single and multi family housing and theaters reinforce Myers s commitment to urbanism and reveal his flexibility with modes of modernism Natalie Shivers introduces the early planning work in Toronto and traces the vacant lottery idea of neighborhood infill to the influential Grand Avenue project in Los Angeles Howard Shubert examines the architectural and planning strategies and political complexities of several civic structures in Canada and the United States Luis Hoyos explores Myers s additions and adaptations to historic buildings in diverse urban contexts Lauren Bricker focuses on the use of steel and other industrial materials in Myers s houses and analyses the neighborhood based designs of his multi family housing Charles Oakley describes the technical innovations site planning and historical underpinnings of Myers s theaters and performance complexes
