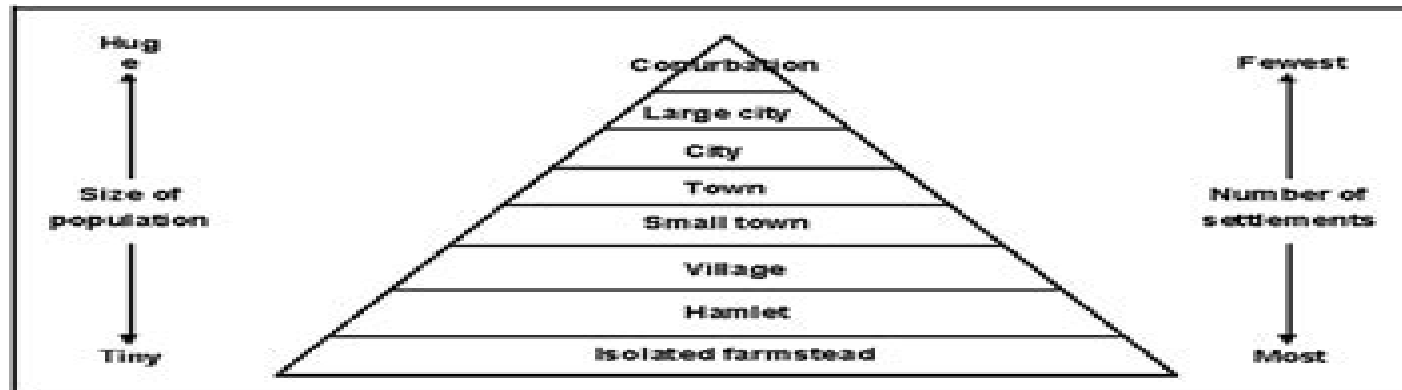

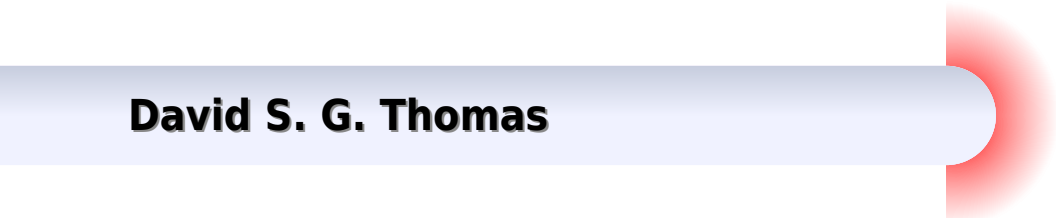
FIGURE 4.1: SETTLEMENT HIERARCHY
