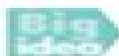

Evolution

Q: How can populations evolve to form new species?

17.1 How do genes make evolution possible?

WHAT I KNOW

SAMPLE ANSWER: There are different variations of the same gene.

WHAT I LEARNED

SAMPLE ANSWER: Evolution occurs when the allele frequency in the gene pool of a population changes over time.

17.2 What makes a population's gene pool change?

SAMPLE ANSWER: Over time useful traits (and the genes that control them) accumulate in a population.

SAMPLE ANSWER: Genetic changes can affect the number and types of possible phenotypes organisms in a population can have. These changes provide the variation that populations need to evolve.

17.3 How do new species form?

SAMPLE ANSWER: The genome of a species changes enough that it becomes a new species.

SAMPLE ANSWER: Speciation sometimes occurs when populations become reproductively isolated.

17.4 What can genes tell us about an organism's evolutionary history?

SAMPLE ANSWER: Some species' genomes are very similar. These species are closely related. The opposite is true for species with very different genomes.

SAMPLE ANSWER: A molecular clock uses mutation rates in DNA to estimate the time that two species have been evolving independently.
