- A space contains at least four non coplanar points

Line Uniqueness Postulate

- Given any two distinct points, there is exactly one line that contains them

Plane Postulate

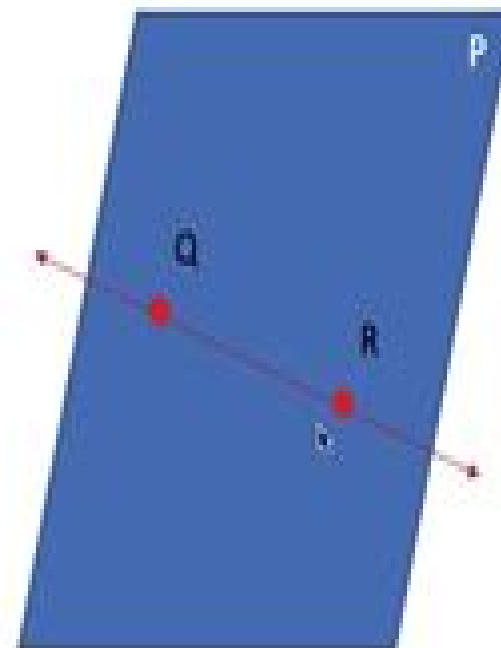
- Any three points lie in at least one plane
- Any three noncollinear points lie in exactly one plane

Plane Intersection Postulate

- If two distinct planes intersect, then their intersection is a line
