Auto/biography in Canada Julie Rak, 2009-08-02 Auto biography in Canada Critical Directions widens the field of auto biography studies with its sophisticated multidisciplinary perspectives on the theory, criticism, and practice of self, community, and representation. Rather than considering autobiography and biography as discrete genres with definable properties, and rather than focusing on critical approaches, the essays explore auto biography as a discourse about identity and representation in the context of numerous disciplinary shifts.
