aesthetics astronomy and history These included the Critique of Practical Reason Kritik der praktischen Vernunft 1788 the Metaphysics of Morals Die Metaphysik der Sitten 1797 which dealt with ethics and the Critique of Judgment Kritik der Urteilkraft 1790 which looks at aesthetics and teleology Reverend Thomas Kingsmill Abbott 26 March 1829 18 December 1913 was an Irish scholar and educator Abbott was born in Dublin and was educated at Trinity College He took his degree in 1851 and was made a fellow of the college in 1854 He obtained an M A and a D Litt from Trinity and was ordained a minister in the Church of Ireland In 1852 he solved a geometrical problem posed by J J Sylvester
