Key Binding Notation

In the Emacs key binding notation, **C-x** is **C-x**!<key>; **M-x** is usually **Alt+x**, **B-x** is **BitBlt+x**, and **C-B-x** is **Ctrl+Alt+B+x**, etc.

Leaving Emacs

visit Emacs (or suspend it in terminal)	C-x
exit Emacs permanently	C-x C-x

Files

read a file into Emacs	C-x C-f
save a file back to disk	C-x C-s
save all files	C-x s
insert contents of another file into this buffer	C-x i
replace this file with the file you really want	C-x C-r
write buffer to a specified file	C-x C-w
toggle read-only status of buffer	C-x C-q

Getting Help

The help system is simple. Type **C-h** (or **F1**) and follow the directions. If you are a first-time user, type **C-h t** for a **tutorial**.

renew help window	C-h i
scroll help window	C-B-v
apropos: show commands matching a string	C-h a
describe the function a key runs	C-h k
describe a function	C-h f
get mode-specific information	C-h m

Error Recovery

abort partially typed or executing command	C-g
recover files lost by a system crash	M-x recover-session
undo an unwanted change	C-u , C-_, or C-/
restore a buffer to its original contents	M-x revert-buffer
redraw garbled screen	C-l

Incremental Search

search forward	C-s
search backward	C-r
regular expression search	C-B-s
reverse regular expression search	C-B-r
select previous search string	B-g
select next search string	B-s
exit incremental search	RET
undo effect of last character	DEL
abort current search	C-g

Use **C-s** or **C-r** again to repeat the search in other direction. If Emacs is still searching, **C-g** cancels only the part not matched.

copy region to kill ring		B-x
kill through next occurrence of char		B-x char
yank back last thing killed		C-y
replace last yank with previous kill		B-y

Marking

set mark here	C-M or C-SPC
exchange point and mark	C-x C-x
set mark (any marks away)	M-M
mark paragraph	M-M
mark page	C-x C-p
mark wrap	C-B-M
mark function	C-B-M
mark entire buffer	C-x h

Query Replace

interactively replace a text string	M-E
using regular expressions	M-x query-replace-regexp
Valid responses in query-replace mode are	
replace this one, go on to next	SPC or y
replace this one, don't move	.
skip to next without replacing	DEL or n
replace all remaining matches	!
back up to the previous match	^
exit query-replace	RET
enter recursive edit (C-B-v to exit)	C-v

Multiple Windows

When two commands are shown, the second is a similar command for a frame instead of a window.

delete all other windows	C-x 1	C-x B 1
split window, above and below	C-x 2	C-x B 2
delete this window	C-x 0	C-x B 0
split window, side by side		C-x 3
scroll other window		C-B-v
switch cursor to another window	C-x a	C-x B a
select buffer in other window	C-x 4 b	C-x B b
display buffer in other window	C-x 4 C-o	C-x B C-o
find file in other window	C-x 4 f	C-x B f
find file read-only in other window	C-x 4 r	C-x B r
run lisp in other window	C-x 4 e	C-x B e
find tag in other window	C-x 4 .	C-x B .
grow window taller		C-x ^

Formatting

indent current line (mode-dependent)	Tab
indent region (mode-dependent)	C-M-i
indent wrap (mode-dependent)	C-M-q
indent region rigidly any columns	C-x TAB
indent for comment	B-1
insert newline after point	C-o
move end of line vertically down	C-B-v
delete blank lines around point	C-x C-o
join line with previous (with arg, text)	B-^
delete all white space around point	B-1
put exactly one space at point	B-SPC
fill paragraph	B-g
set all columns to arg	C-x f
set profile such line starts with	C-x .

Case Change

uppercase word	B-u
lowercase word	B-l
capitalize word	B-c
uppercase region	C-x C-u
lowercase region	C-x C-l

The Minibuffer

The following keys are defined in the minibuffer.

complete as much as possible	TAB
complete up to one word	SPC
complete and execute	RET
show possible completions	?
fetch previous minibuffer input	B-g
fetch later minibuffer input or default	B-s
regrab search backward through history	B-r
regrab search forward through history	B-s
abort command	C-g

Type **C-x ESC RET** to edit and repeat the last command that used the minibuffer. Type **F10** to activate mouse bar icons on text terminals.

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
