

civil rights organizations sports were also a key arena for Black resistance to white supremacy Drawing from a rich trove of primary sources Chiles recounts the development of Black football and basketball culture at the high school and college levels in Virginia from the 1890s to the early 1970s Looking beyond their role as leisure pastimes Chiles demonstrates how amateur sports strengthened education neutralized class divisions shaped Black masculinity mentored Black male leadership cultivated race pride and reflected Black desires for urban modernity Illuminating the ways Black athletes created a world that pushed for racial progress through objective meritocratic achievement anchored by masculine leadership and institutional success Playing for Power traces how amateur sports coalesced into a key cultural institution that fostered Black Virginians collective sense of community achievement and purpose during segregation cornerstones of later advances in the Civil Rights Movement Playing for Power also contributes to a larger understanding of sports history and how amateur sports became favorite American spectacles and markers of Southern identity Chiles s groundbreaking work will interest historians scholars and individuals interested in the intersection of sports and civil rights and the history of Black sports during the Jim Crow era

The African American Press in World War II Paul Alkebulan, 2014-04-17 Black journalists have vigorously exercised their First Amendment right since the founding of Freedom s Journal in 1827 World War II was no different in this regard and Paul Alkebulan argues that it was the most important moment in the long history of that important institution American historians have often postulated that WWII was a pivotal moment for the modern civil rights movement This argument is partially based on the pressing need to convincingly appeal to the patriotism and self interest of black citizens in the fight against fascism and its racial doctrines This appeal would have to recognize long standing and well known grievances of African Americans and offer some immediate resolution to these problems such as increased access to better housing and improved job prospects 230 African American newspapers were prime actors in this struggle Black editors and journalists gave a coherent and organized voice to the legitimate aspirations and grievances of African Americans for decades prior to WWII In addition they presented an alternative and more inclusive vision of democracy The African American Press in World War II Toward Victory at Home and Abroad shows how they accomplished this goal and is different from other works in this field because it interprets WWII at home and abroad through the eyes of a diverse black press Alkebulan shows the wide ranging interest of the press prior to the war and during the conflict Labor union struggles equal funding for black education the criminal justice system and the Italian invasion of Ethiopia were some of subjects covered before and during the war Historians tend to write as if the African American press was ideologically homogenous but according to Alkebulan this is not the case For example prior to the war African American journalists were both sympathetic and opposed to Japanese ambitions in the Pacific A Philip Randolph s socialist journal The Messenger accurately warned against Imperial Japan s activities in Asia during WWI There are other instances that run counter to the common wisdom During World War II the Negro Newspaper Publishers Association not only pursued equal rights at home but also lectured

blacks military and civilian about the need to avoid any behavior that would have a negative impact on the public image of the civil rights movement The African American Press in World War II explores press coverage of international affairs in more depth than similar works The African American press tended to conflate the civil rights movement with the anti colonial struggle taking place in Africa Asia and the Caribbean Alkebulan demonstrates how George Padmore and W E B Du Bois were instrumental in this trend While it heightened interest in anti colonialism it also failed to delineate crucial differences between fighting for national independence and demanding equal citizenship rights in one s native land

The Seedtime, the Work, and the Harvest Jeffrey L. Littlejohn, Reginald K. Ellis, Peter B. Levy, 2019-10-07 This volume s contributors expand the chronology and geography of the black freedom struggle beyond the traditional emphasis on the Jim Crow South and the years between 1954 and 1968 Beginning as far back as the nineteenth century and analyzing case studies from southern northern and border states the essays in The Seedtime the Work and the Harvest incorporate communities and topics not usually linked to the African American civil rights movement The collection opens with a biographical sketch of Thomas DeSaille Tucker an educational pioneer who served as the first president of Florida State Normal and Industrial School for Colored Students It then highlights the work of black women including Bostonian publisher Josephine St Pierre Ruffin who defied local governments during the Progressive Era by disseminating medical information and providing access to medical professionals Next the collection explores the life and work of Norfolk civil rights attorney James F Gay who helped to democratize the political establishment in Virginia s largest city but became a victim of his own success The collection then moves to York Pennsylvania to examine a 1969 riot that went mostly unnoticed until the town s mayor was charged more than thirty years later with the riot related murder of Lillie Belle Allen Also featured is an essay examining the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee s Food for Freedom campaign that aimed to complement voter registration work in Mississippi by providing everyday sustenance to African Americans Addressing more recent issues this volume considers the politics of public memory in Baltimore Maryland a city divided by racial riots in 1968 and in 2015 It then examines the Black Lives Matter movement that gained international attention for its response to Michael Brown s death at the hands of police in Ferguson Missouri as well as the Sandra Bland Movement inspired by the arrest of Bland and her subsequent death in the Waller County jail in rural Texas These chapters connect the activism of today shaped in so many ways by social media student activism and grassroots organization to a deeply historical wide ranging fight for equality

Cardinal Dreams Danny Spewak, 2024-03-05 The untold story of one of the first Black players for the St Louis Cardinals who dreamed of leaving a lasting impact on Major League Baseball Charlie Peete was poised for greatness After a meteoric rise through the minor leagues the rookie outfielder appeared in twenty three games for the St Louis Cardinals during the summer of 1956 and established himself as one of the best prospects in the organization until a cruel twist of fate intervened On his way to Venezuela to compete in a winter baseball league Peete and his family died in a plane crash near Caracas Nearly seven decades later Cardinal Dreams

revitalizes the legacy of Charlie Peete with the most comprehensive account to date of his remarkable life including personal interviews with those who knew him and played with him Raised under Jim Crow laws in southeastern Virginia Peete broke into professional baseball in 1950 with the Negro American League s Indianapolis Clowns served his country admirably for two years in the U S Army during the Korean War returned home to help integrate the Class B Piedmont League with the Portsmouth Merrimacs and then climbed to the top of the St Louis Cardinals organization at a time of rapid change under new ownership Had Peete not lost his life in that plane crash he likely would have become the first Black position player in franchise history to earn a permanent starting job Charlie Peete s death stunned the St Louis Cardinals and left the baseball world to forever wonder what his career might have become But despite his premature and tragic ending Peete changed the world for the better and left a lasting impact on the sport he spent his life pursuing

Winford,2019-12-09 WINNER OF THE LILLIAN SMITH BOOK AWARD John Hervey Wheeler 1908 1978 was one of the civil rights movement s most influential leaders In articulating a bold vision of regional prosperity grounded in full citizenship and economic power for African Americans this banker lawyer and visionary would play a key role in the fight for racial and economic equality throughout North Carolina Utilizing previously unexamined sources from the John Hervey Wheeler Collection at the Atlanta University Center Robert W Woodruff Library this biography explores the black freedom struggle through the life of North Carolina s most influential black power broker After graduating from Morehouse College Wheeler returned to Durham and began a decades long career at Mechanics and Farmers M F Bank He started as a teller and rose to become bank president in 1952 In 1961 President Kennedy appointed Wheeler to the President s Committee on Equal Employment Opportunity a position in which he championed equal rights for African Americans and worked with Vice President Johnson to draft civil rights legislation One of the first blacks to attain a high position in the state s Democratic Party Wheeler became the state party s treasurer in 1968 and then its financial director Wheeler urged North Carolina s white financial advisors to steer the region toward the end of Jim Crow segregation for economic reasons Straddling the line between confrontation and negotiation Wheeler pushed for increased economic opportunity for African Americans while reminding the white South that its future was linked to the plight of black southerners

Sweet Georgia Brown Lawrence E. Walker,2019-01-31 Charity Adams Earley commander of the 6888th Central Postal Directory Battalion in World War II summarized the history of women in the military when she wrote in 1989 The future of women in the military seems assured What may be lost in time is the story of how it happened The barriers of sex and race were and sometimes still are very difficult to overcome the second even more than the first During World War II

women in the service were often subject to ridicule and disrespect even as they performed satisfactorily Each year the number of people who shared the stress of these accomplishments lessens In another generation young black women who join the military will have scant record of their predecessors who fought on the two fronts of discrimination segregation and reluctant acceptance by males

Charles N. Hunter and Race Relations in North Carolina John H. Haley, 2014-07-02 Charles N Hunter one of North Carolina's outstanding black reformers was born a slave in Raleigh around 1851 and he lived there until his death in 1931 As public school teacher journalist and historian Hunter devoted his long life to improving opportunities for blacks A political activist but never a radical he skillfully used his journalistic abilities and his personal contacts with whites to publicize the problems and progress of his race He urged blacks to ally themselves with the best of the white leaders and he constantly reminded whites that their treatment of his race ran counter to their professed religious beliefs and the basic tenets of the American liberal tradition By carefully balancing his efforts Hunter helped to establish a spirit of passive protest against racial injustice John Haley's compelling book largely based on Hunter's voluminous papers affords a unique opportunity to view race relations in North Carolina through the eyes of a black man It also provides the first continuous survey of the black experience in the state from the end of the Civil War to the Great Depression an account that critiques the belief that race relations were better in North Carolina than in other southern states

Carter G. Woodson Burnis R. Morris, 2017-09-25 This study reveals how historian Carter G Woodson 1875 1950 used the black press and modern public relations techniques to popularize black history during the first half of the twentieth century Explanations for Woodson's success with the modern black history movement usually include his training deep rooted principles and single minded determination Often overlooked however is Woodson's skillful use of newspapers in developing and executing a public education campaign built on truth accuracy fairness and education Burnis R Morris explains how Woodson attracted mostly favorable news coverage for his history movement due to his deep understanding of the newspapers business and editorial models as well as his public relations skills which helped him merge the interests of the black press with his cause Woodson's publicity tactics combined with access to the audiences granted him by the press enabled him to drive the black history movement particularly observance of Negro History Week and fundraising activities Morris analyzes Woodson's periodicals newspaper articles letters and other archived documents describing Woodson's partnership with the black press and his role as a publicist This rarely explored side of Woodson who was often called the Father of Black History reintroduces Woodson's lost image as a leading cultural icon who used his celebrity in multiple roles as an opinion journalist newsmaker and publicist of black history to bring veneration to a disrespected subject During his active professional career 1915 1950 Woodson merged his interests and the interests of the black newspapers His cause became their cause

The Golden Thirteen Dan Goldberg, 2020-05-19 The inspiring story of the 13 courageous Black men who integrated the U S Navy during World War II leading desegregation efforts across America and anticipating the civil rights movement Featuring previously
