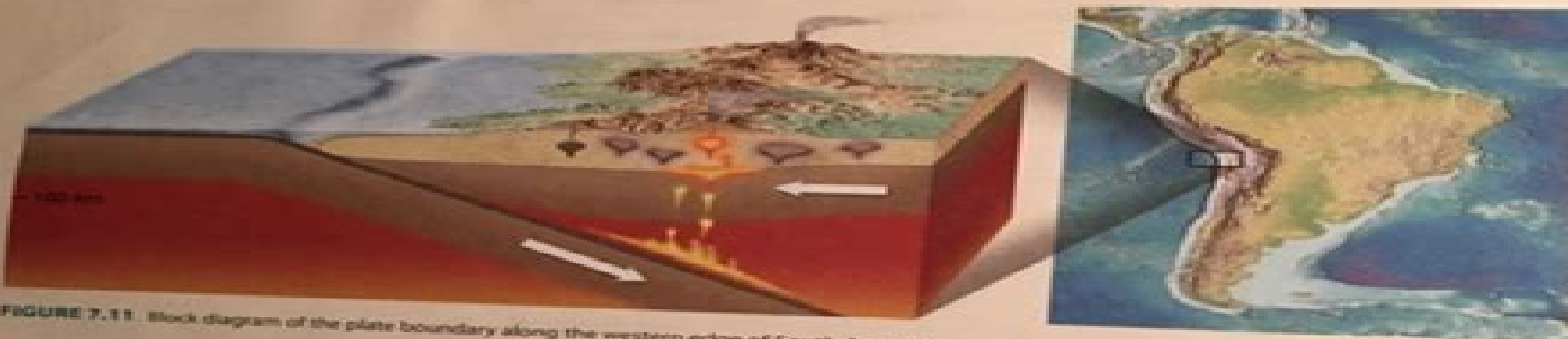


FIGURE 7.11 Block diagram of the plate boundary along the western edge of South America.
