focuses on some of the fundamental techniques that are legal for Sambo competition. The purpose of this study was to examine and compare the most successfully used submission techniques of three of the greatest figures in the history of sambo competition. Michael Burdikov Alex Feodorov and David Rudman Sambo has become well known largely due to the success of Sambo fighters in various mixed martial art venues.
