Qa) Write an account of the developments leading to Roosevelt's 1932 election (15 r)

Hoover's lack of popularity following the Wall Street Crash of 1929 was a factor in Roosevelt's victory in 1932. Hoover was referred to as the 'do nothing' president due to his perceived lack of action and presence during the subsequent economic crisis. Many Americans despised him. Various items in the 1930s were given nicknames in his honor. Hoover's name to show their contempt of him; shanty towns that sprung up after the crash were termed 'Hoovervilles', pieces of cardboard that people used to repair their homes were termed 'Hoover Leather' and Ford Model T's which were pulled apart to fuel them were called 'Hoover's'.
During the 1920s, there were significant changes in the lives of some women. White, middle-class, urban women were given more freedom and, taking advantage of this newfound liberation, were able to move away from their traditional gender roles for the first time. However, this was only a relatively small percentage of women, and for the vast majority there was far more continuity than change. As a result, it could be reasonably argued that the changes in the lives of women over the 1920s were of limited importance.

Qa) Write an account of the growth of popular culture in the USA (15 marks)

The entertainment industries grew massively in the 1920s, leading to a change in social attitudes and increased wealth. There came an increase in disposable income from salary increases, coupled with reduced working hours (from 47 to 44 hours per week). This led to more time and money to invest in leisure and entertainment, thus stimulating the industry.

Firstly, immediately following the Wall Street Crash of 1929, 659 banks failed. This led to a loss of trust in the banking system. In 1930, another 1352 banks went bankrupt. American citizens became anxious and panicked and withdrew billions of dollars' worth of savings across the country. These bank closures had a significant impact on the American people and their businesses and contributed to the Great Depression.
