The Hunger Games by Suzanne Collins

Questions for Part One, Chapters 1-3

1. In which district does Katniss live? Why do you think her neighborhood is nicknamed "the Seam"?

Katniss lives in District 12. Answers will vary but should refer to Katniss living near the edge, or seam, of District 12.

2. How are Gale and Prim important to Katniss?

Gale is Katniss' hunting partner and the only person with whom she can be herself. Prim is Katniss' younger sister and the only person Katniss is certain that she loves.

3. Explain Gale's anger at Midge. What is the real source of Gale's anger?

Gale resents that Midge, as the mayor's daughter, does not have to sign up for tesserae, while he has to sign up for himself and each member of his large family. Gale is angry at the Capitol for controlling the people and affecting the social classes.

4. What is the Treaty of Treason?

The Treaty of Treason is result of the districts rebelling against the Capitol, brought about lies to guarantee peace and instituted the Hunger Games.

5. What are the Hunger Games? What is their purpose?

Once a year, every district must send one boy and one girl tribute to an arena where 24 tributes fight to the death on live TV. Viewing is mandatory. The Hunger Games are a yearly punishment to the districts and serve as a reminder against rebellion.

6. Why does Katniss volunteer to participate in the Hunger Games?

Answers will vary, but students should discuss how Katniss loves Prim more than anything and would rather face death than lose her sister.

7. How do people in District 12 react to Katniss becoming a tribute?

The people show their disapproval of the Games by remaining silent when asked to applaud and then show respect for Katniss by saluting her with an old gesture that means thanks, admiration, and good-bye to a loved one.

8. Why is Katniss upset when Peeta is chosen as a tribute?

Katniss never thanked Peeta for the time he saved her family from starvation, and now they will be trying to kill each other.
