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Minerals Yearbook Geological Survey, Interior Department, Mines Bureau, 2019-01-31 This volume covering metals and minerals contains chapters on approximately 90 commodities In addition this volume has chapters on mining and quarrying trends and on statistical surveying methods used by Minerals Information plus a statistical summary Multidisciplinary Perspectives on Zimbabwe's Liberation Struggle Munyaradzi Nyakudya, Wesley Mwatwara, Joseph Mujere, 2022-11-15 This book provides a timely reconceptualization of Zimbabwe's anti colonial liberation struggle resisting simple binaries in favour of more nuanced critical analysis Most historiographies characterize Zimbabwe's liberation struggle as being defined by simple bifurcations along racial ethnic class and ideological perspectives This book argues that the nationalist struggle is far more complex than such simple configurations would suggest and that many actors have been overlooked in the analysis The book broadens our understanding by analysing the roles of a wide range of political figures organizations and members of the military as well as the media and the often overlooked part that women played Over the course of the book the contributors also reflect on the ways in which revolutionary figures have been repainted as sellouts in particular by the ZANU PF ruling party and what that means for the country's interpretation of their recent past Highlighting in particular the expertise of leading scholars from within Zimbabwe across a range of disciplines this book will be of interest to researchers of African history politics and postcolonial studies **PHilMech**, 2010 Breaking Point Rebecca Schwartz Greene, 2023-01-03 WINNER SOCIETY FOR MILITARY HISTORY DISTINGUISHED BOOK AWARDS FIRST BOOK This book informs the public for the first time about the impact of American psychiatry on soldiers during World War II Breaking Point is the first in depth history of American psychiatry in World War II Drawn from unpublished primary documents oral histories and the author's personal interviews and correspondence over years with key psychiatric and military policymakers it begins with Franklin Roosevelt's endorsement of a universal Selective Service psychiatric examination followed by Army and Navy pre and post induction examinations Ultimately 2.5 million men and women were rejected or discharged from military service on neuropsychiatric grounds Never before or since has the United States engaged in such a program In designing Selective Service Medical Circular No 1 psychiatrist Harry Stack Sullivan assumed psychiatrists could predict who might break down or falter in military service or even in civilian life thereafter While many American and European psychiatrists questioned this belief and huge numbers of American psychiatric casualties soon raised questions about screening's validity psychiatric and military leaders persisted in 1942 and 1943 in endorsing ever tougher screening and little else Soon families complained of fathers and teens being drafted instead of being identified as psychiatric 4Fs and Blacks and Native Americans among others complained of bias A frustrated General George S Patton famously slapped two malingering neuropsychiatric patients in Sicily a sentiment shared by Marshall and Eisenhower though they favored a tamer style Yet psychiatric rejections evacuations and discharges mounted While psychiatrist Roy Grinker and a few others treated soldiers close to the front in

Tunisia in early 1943 this was the exception But as demand for manpower soared and psychiatrists finally went to the field and saw that combat itself not predisposition precipitated breakdown leading military psychiatrists switched their emphasis from screening to prevention and treatment But this switch was too little too late and slowed by a year long series of Inspector General investigations even while numbers of psychiatric casualties soared Ironically despite and even partly because of psychiatrists wartime performance plus the emotional toll of war postwar America soon witnessed a dramatic growth in numbers popularity and influence of the profession culminating in the National Mental Health Act 1946 But veterans with PTSD not recognized until 1980 were largely neglected

Counter-Recruitment and the Campaign to Demilitarize Public Schools Scott Harding, Seth Kershner, 2016-04-29 This book describes the various tactics used in counter recruitment drawing from the words of activists and case studies of successful organizing and advocacy The United States is one of the only developed countries to allow a military presence in public schools including an active role for military recruiters In order to enlist 250 000 new recruits every year the US military must market itself to youth by integrating itself into schools through programs such as JROTC Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps and spend billions of dollars annually on recruitment activities This militarization of educational space has spawned a little noticed grassroots resistance the small but sophisticated counter recruitment movement Counter recruiters visit schools to challenge recruiters messages with information on non military career options activists work to make it harder for the military to operate in public schools they conduct lobbying campaigns for policies that protect students private information from military recruiters and counter recruiters mentor youth to become involved in these activities While attracting little attention counter recruitment has nonetheless been described as the military recruiter s greatest obstacle by a Marine Corps official

New England Federalists Dinah Mayo-Bobee, 2017-01-31 Beginning with controversies related to British and French attacks on U S neutral trade in 1805 this book looks at crucial developments in national politics public policy and foreign relations from the perspective of New England Federalists Through its focus on the partisan climate in Congress that appeared to influence federal statutes New England Federalists Widening the Sectional Divide in Jeffersonian America sets out to explain in their own words why Federalists especially those often deemed extreme or radical by contemporaries and historians alike escalated a campaign to repeal the Constitution s three fifths clause which included slaves in the calculation for congressional representation and votes in the Electoral College while encouraging violations of federal law and advocating northern secession from the Union Unlike traditional interpretations of early nineteenth century politics that focus on Jeffersonian political economy this study brings the impetus for Federalist obstructionism and sectionalism into sharp relief Federalists who became the sole defenders of New England s economic independence and free labor force later issued calls for northerners to unite against the spread of slavery and southern control of the central government Along with controversies that placed sectional harmony in jeopardy this work links themes in Federalist opposition rhetoric to the

important antislavery arguments that would flourish in antebellum culture and politics The Rocket Lab Michael G. Smith,2023-05-15 The Rocket Lab Maurice Zucrow Purdue University and America s Race to Space focuses on the golden era of space exploration between 1946 and 1966 specifically the life and times of Purdue University s Dr Maurice J Zucrow a pioneering teacher and researcher in aerospace engineering Zucrow taught America s first university course in jet and rocket propulsion wrote the field s first textbook and established the country s first educational Rocket Lab He was part of a small circle of innovators who transformed Purdue into the country s largest engineering university which became a cradle of astronauts Taking a chronological and thematic approach The Rocket Lab weaves between the local and national drawing in rival universities especially Harvard MIT Princeton and Caltech Also covered is Zucrow s role in the national project system of research and development through World War II and the Cold War At Aerojet he was one of the country s original project engineers dedicated to scientific technical expertise and the stepwise approach He made vanguard power plant contributions to the Northrop Flying Wing as well as the Corporal Nike and Atlas missiles among others Zucrow s work in propulsion helped to improve the country s arsenal of ballistic missiles and space launchers and as a teacher he educated the first generation of aerospace engineers This book elevates Zucrow and the central role he played in getting the United States to space **Staff Papers** United States.
