

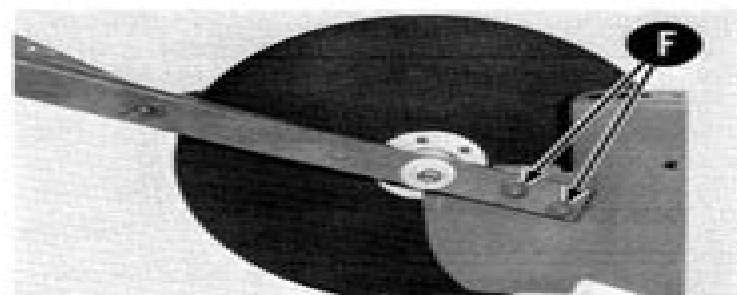
PREPARING YOUR MACHINE FOR WORK

CURRENT FURROW OPENERS

SINGLE DISK NOTCHED LANDSIDE FURROW OPENERS - for 16 x 8" Drills Built 1975 and Since

To adjust the boot, loosen or tighten the two nuts at "F" in Illust. 7A above and below the rocker rib pivot until the edge of the boot is barely touching the disk so it will scrape loose and moist soil from the disk.

Inside scrapers which prevent build up in wet sticky soils can be obtained through service parts by ordering 603 620 R11 for left openers and 603 621 R11 for right openers. Remove the scrapers when not required.

PRESSURE SPRING ADJUSTMENT - for Single and Double Disk Furrow Openers

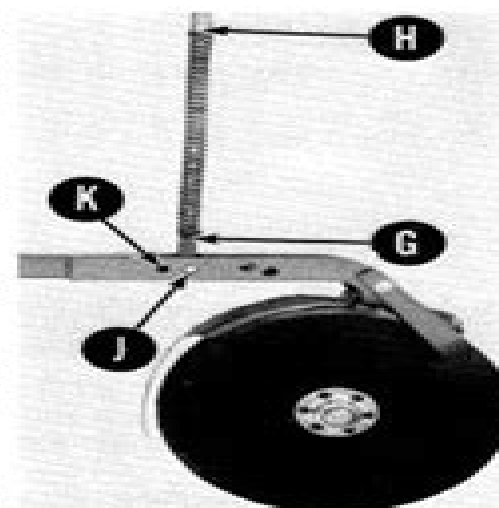
Assemble the W-shaped keep at "G" in the bottom hole for minimum furrow opener spring pressure. The flat cotter at "H" should be located in the middle hole for average working conditions. This setting allows the furrow openers to follow irregularities in the field.

Placing the flat cotter at "H" in a higher hole in the pressure rod will increase the working depth of the furrow opener and decrease the ground clearance for transporting.

Placing the flat cotter at "H" in a lower hole limits the working depth of the opener and increases the ground clearance for transporting.

The W-shaped keep at "G" controls the amount of spring pressure on the furrow openers. Raising the W-shaped keep increases the pressure on the furrow openers, lowering the W-shaped keep decreases the pressure on the furrow openers.

IMPORTANT: The furrow openers that run in the tracks made by the tractor wheels require extra pressure to penetrate the packed soil. Extra pressure can be applied by inserting the W-shaped keep at "G" one or two holes higher than the other furrow openers.

On double disk furrow openers, the pressure rod should be attached to the rear hole in the front furrow openers as shown at "J" and to the front hole in the rear furrow openers as indicated by "K".
