The Nervous System

The nervous system is a complex, specialised network of cells in the human body and it is the primary internal system of communication. The cells involved carry messages to and from the brain so that all parts of the body can communicate with each other.

The nervous system contains all the neurons in the body (estimated as 15-20 billion) and various parts of the system are specialised for different functions.


· To do its job effectively, the brain needs to receive input from the body's sensory receptors (touch and pain receptors on the skin, taste etc. This information is carried along SENSORY PARTITIONATS that run from sensory receptors to the spinal cord and then on to the brain.

Neurons making up these sensory patheory are called SENSORY REUBONS.

In order to control movement, the brain needs to connect and communicate to muscles of the skeleton. It also needs to control the functioning of internal organs (heart, digestive system). PACTOR PATHWAYS allow the brain to control movement and the response of internal systems.

Neurons making up these motor pathways are called MOTOR NEURONS.

. We also have BILAY NEURONS which operate entirely within the CNS, interconnecting different parts of the brain to the
