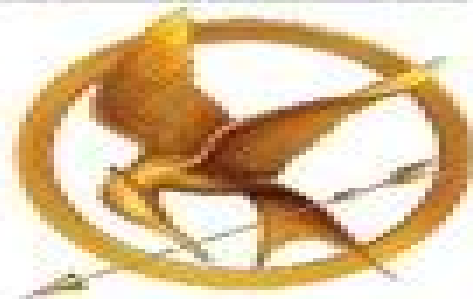


Hunger Games: Dialectical Journals

Then write a brief paragraph about why you chose it (e.g., I liked it..., I didn't like it..., it made me think of..., etc.). You will meet with members of your district groups every three chapters throughout the novel to share these passages and ideas with your group members.

This passage shows the importance of food in <i>The Hunger Games</i>, and how it is a powerful motivator.</p>
