banner somewhere downtown and regularly gleefully repeated by our local feature writers Houston is a port city on top of a swamp and yes it has no zoning laws And that means it s culturally diverse internally incongruous and ever changing At any intersection here I might look out my car window and see a horse idly munching St Augustine grass And within spitting distance of that horse I might see a spa that s an obvious brothel a house turned drug den or a swiftly rising bayou that might overtake a car if the rain doesn t let up Overall this collection represents the very worst our city has to
