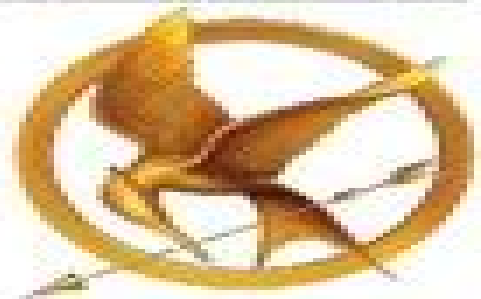


Hunger Games: Dialectical Journals

This passage shows the importance of food in <i>The Hunger Games</i>, and how it is a powerful motivator.</p>
