Cindy goes to the ball and meets Hans Summ, singer of the best-selling band the Charmers, yet the tale ends differently from the way your students will anticipate. The script is intended for 9 readers, but the number of readers can easily be contracted or expanded, depending on how many groups you wish to have.

After finishing the script students have to discuss and write on five questions, do a script writing task, write a fractured story plot pitch AND perform a fun jokes activity.
