HOW TO PREVENT EMI ?

There are some precautions you can take:

- Do not turn on or use hand-held personal communication devices, such as citizens band (CB) radios and cellular phones, while your scooter is turned on.
- Try not to operate your scooter too close to the transmitters, such as radio or TV stations and hand-held or mobile two-way radios. For example, if you are on an electric mobility vehicle with a resistance level of 20 V/m, you should remain at least 1 meter from a hand-held two-way radio and at least 10 centimeters from a mobile two-way radio.
- Be aware that adding accessories and/or components, or modifying your scooter in any way may change its EMI resistance level and may make it more susceptible to interference from radio wave sources. There is no simple way to evaluate the effect of such actions on resistance level of a scooter.

If unintended motion or unintended brake release occurs, turn off your scooter by removing the key as soon as possible.
