- The monarchy overspent and the government went bankrupt, and the king was weak.
- A writer, Rousseau, wrote that it was wrong for a king to have absolute power, and the idea became popular among the people.



The **Rights of Man** was adopted, which was like America's "All men are created equal." It stated that "Men are born free and remain free and equal in rights". A parliament was set up similar to Britain's called the **Convention**.
