- Health: is a state of complete physical, mental and social well-being and not merely the absence of disease
 - Public health: refers to all organized measures to prevent disease, promote health, and prolong life among the population as a whole
 - 3. Environment: all that which is external to the individual hos
 - 4. Environmental health: is the discipline that focuses on the interrelationships between people and their environment, promotes human health and well-being, and fosters a safe and healthful environment
 - Three main components of environmental health: population-based Focus on environmental stressors Not driven by individual behaviors
 - Ecology: the study of the interactions between organisms and their environments, including both the living (biotic) and nonliving (abiotic) components
 - biosphere: the largest known ecosystem, in which all other ecosystems are embedded; it consists of all the Earth's living organisms interacting with the physical environment
 - 8. Biomes: the major geographic regions, including the tundra, boreal forest, temperate forest, tropical forest, scrub land, grassland and savannah, desert, and their relevant subtypes
 - 9. Trophic structure: the organization of ecosystems by feeding levels, often conveniently conceptualized as a pyramid
 - primary consumer: feed upon primary producers, and are in turn fed upon by secondary consumers, or heterotrophs.
 - Autoroph: a primary producer that obtains energy directly from the sun through photosynthesis
 - Ecosystem Functioning: Naturally mediated and regulated ecological processes, such as the breakdown of organic waste and the recycling of chemical elements
 - adaptive renewal cycle: repeated cycles of change
