METAPHOR DEFINITION



- A metaphor is a form of figurative language. A metaphor is a
 rhetorical device in which an object, idea or situation is referred to
 directly as something it is not. It moves away from referring to
 something in a literal sense, and refers to it as something else in
 order to create a more imaginative figure of speech and description
 of something.
- When used as a literary device, a metaphor can add a more detailed and complex description to something giving the reader a more in depth experience. A metaphor is more easily able to convey an idea or an emotion than by simply using a literal statement.
