- Discuss in what capacity the report was originally used and how it may be used in alternative venues. For example, can this report be utilized by other professionals in the future? If so, in what capacity?
 - Discuss the quality and readability of this report, including a scholarly critique of the writing. Identify information that is absent from the report.
- Explain how you would use the recommendations in the report to assist in the development
 of a treatment plan.

 Apply considerations of expert witness testimony learned from the previous modules and any information that you found missing in the report. Develop questions that the court would likely ask the evaluator.

Your essay should rely upon at least seven scholarly resources from the professional literature that are cited in APA format. The literature may include the Argosy University online library resources; relevant textbooks; peer-reviewed journal articles; and websites created by professional organizations, agencies, or institutions (.edu, .org, or .gov).
