 - b. Maintain homeostasis (internal constancy)
2. Cells
 - a. All organisms are made of membrane-bound cells
3. Information
 - a. All organisms process hereditary information and information from the environment
4. Growth and replication
 - a. All organisms are capable of growth and reproduction
5. Evolution
 - a. Populations of organisms are continually evolving

 - Protista (multiple kingdoms)
 - Unicellular or multicellular
 - Autotrophs or heterotrophs

- The matter that makes up life is organized into atoms
 - All matter, living and nonliving, is composed of atoms
 - Atom: the smallest chemical unit of a type of pure substance (element).
 - Example: Carbon atom
- Atoms are organized into molecules
 - Molecule: a group of joined atoms.
 - Example: DNA
