Laborers and Enslaved Workers Marcelo Badaró Mattos, 2017-09-01 From the middle of the nineteenth century until the 1888 abolition of slavery in Brazil Rio de Janeiro was home to the largest urban population of enslaved workers anywhere in the Americas It was also the site of an incipient working class consciousness that expressed itself across seemingly distinct social categories In this volume Marcelo Badar Mattos demonstrates that these two historical phenomena cannot be understood in isolation Drawing on a wide range of historical sources Badar Mattos reveals the diverse labor arrangements and associative life of Rio s working class from which emerged the many strategies that workers both free and unfree pursued in their struggles against oppression

Howley, 2025-10 This volume assembles twenty two scholars from the fields of classics and early Christian studies to interrogate the intersections between writing and enslavement around the Roman Mediterranean Drawing upon methods developed in scholarship on book history and Atlantic slavery the authors demonstrate the myriad ways in which the material and intellectual contributions of enslaved literary workers were vital to the composition editing copying circulation reading and preservation of Roman texts This thematically organized volume exposes the ways that power dynamics denigrate and erase enslaved contributors as well as how language barriers gender difference and disability created dependence on enslaved workers The central role of enslaved workers in practical work like bookkeeping education and divination is explored in addition to the unseen labor of enslaved collators note keepers editors and curators Enslaved workers were a constitutive part of the Roman knowledge economy their roles in allowing others to read and write in producing ancient literature and in staffing the bureaucratic structures of the Roman empire were profound Roman literature technology and knowledge depended on the labor and expertise of enslaved literate workers and these chapters argue that they influenced just about every aspect of Roman life

Before Middle Passage: Translated Portuguese Manuscripts of Atlantic Slave Trading from West Africa to Iberian Territories, 1513-26 Trevor P. Hall, 2016-03-09 On the 20th of January 1526 the Santiago left Lisbon bound for Africa with a cargo of brass and tin bracelets round bells barber basins and cloth by early October the ship was back in Portugal with a very different cargo 108 enslaved Africans With chilling detachment the ship s trading log records the commodification of human beings the prices paid for them the sums received for their sale and the number who did not survive the crossing Whilst this log may be extremely rare it is clear from another surviving document the receipt book of the customs office of the Portuguese Cape Verde Islands that such voyages were commonplace in the early years of the sixteenth century The bulk of this volume consists of a translation into English of the receipt book from the customs office of the Cape Verde Islands In it Portuguese customs agents recorded import duties on over 3 000 slaves transported from nearby West Africa in 36 ships The customs officers named the slave

traders ships officers crew and outfitters of the ships as well as the price of each slave and the import duty collected by the Portuguese government and the Catholic Church A second section of the customs book provides details of export taxes paid on c 600 African slaves by merchants from Portugal Spain and the Spanish Canary Islands when they exchanged European merchandise for slaves The final chapter of the volume translates the Santiago s log providing an example of an actual slave trading expedition Taken together these documents open a rare window into the workings and scope of the early Atlantic slave trade

Public Theatre and the Enslaved People of Colonial Saint-Domingue Julia Prest,2023-04-13 The French colony of Saint Domingue now Haiti was home to one of the richest public theatre traditions of the colonial era Caribbean This book examines the relationship between public theatre and the enslaved people of Saint Domingue something that is generally given short shrift owing to a perceived lack of documentation Here a range of materials and methodologies are used to explore pressing questions including the mitigated spectatorship of the enslaved portrayals of enslaved people in French and Creole repertoire the contributions of enslaved people to theatre making and shifting attitudes during the revolutionary era The book demonstrates that slavery was no mere backdrop to this portion of theatre history but an integral part of its story It also helps recover the hidden experiences of some of the enslaved individuals who became entangled in that story

Peasant Rebellion in a Slave Society Matthias Röhrig Assunção, 2024-07-11 *Peasant Rebellion in a Slave Society* identifies the immediate and remote reasons for the Balaiada revolt in Maranhão Brazil analyzing the special characteristics of the region that favored the development of a relatively independent peasantry within and around the cotton rice cassava and cattle estates The book explores the demography of Maranhão and patterns of land ownership and documents the rapid degradation of the environment by plantation based export agriculture The analysis of various types of coerced and free labor the oligopolistic structure of the colonial economy and the key determinants of class and status contextualizes the conflict potential in Maranhão during the first half of the nineteenth century The People of Color as they called themselves and enslaved workers from plantations rose against a White and conservative elite claiming their constitutional rights or their freedom The central government in Rio de Janeiro had to dispatch considerable amounts of money and troops to defeat the insurrection and subject the province again to imperial rule and enslaved workers and peasants to the plantocracy This richly illustrated volume will be of interest to students and scholars working on slavery in the Americas and the Atlantic world as well as Brazilian history

The Illustrated Slave Martha J. Cutter, 2017-08-15 From the 1787 Wedgwood antislavery medallion featuring the image of an enchained and pleading black body to Quentin Tarantino s *Django Unchained* 2012 and Steve McQueen s *Twelve Years a Slave* 2013 slavery as a system of torture and bondage has fascinated the optical imagination of the transatlantic world Scholars have examined various aspects of the visual culture that was slavery including its painting sculpture pamphlet campaigns and artwork Yet an important piece of this visual culture has gone unexamined the popular and frequently reprinted antislavery illustrated books published prior to Harriet Beecher Stowe s *Uncle Tom s Cabin* 1852 that were utilized extensively by the antislavery movement in the first half of the nineteenth century *The Illustrated Slave* analyzes some of the more innovative works in the archive of antislavery illustrated books published from 1800 to 1852 alongside other visual materials that depict enslavement Martha J. Cutter argues that some illustrated narratives attempt to
