Couplet	A stanza consisting of two lines; Couplets often rhyme	Parting is such sweet sorrow, That I shall say good night till it be morn. From <i>Romeo and Juliet</i> (Shakespeare)
Figurative Language	Creative comparisons that are not literally true	Love is a homeless guy searching for treasure in the middle of the rain and finding a bag of gold coins and slowly finding out they're all filled with chocolate and even though he's heart broken, he can't complain because he was hungry in the first place. "Love Is" (Bo Burnham)
Form	The way a poem is laid out on the page	The wind was a torrent of darkness among the gusty trees, The moon was a ghostly galleon tossed upon cloudy seas, The road was a ribbon of moonlight over the purple moor, And the highwayman came riding— Riding—riding— The highwayman came riding, up to the old inn-door.
