- 2 If it happens suddenly... It is not a reservoir effect.
- 3 The longer the flow period, the more information you can extract from the buildup.
- A It is better to measure something than to calculate it.
- Good measurements cost money. Bad ones cost more!
- 6. Be very critical of all data.
- Use end points (e.g. pi') as anchor points, to guide your interpretation.
- Interpolate with no fear. Extrapolate only based on mechanistic models.
- What the recorder sees, is not always what the reservoir sees.
- 1 () Wellborg transients will dominate over reservoir transients.
- 1.1 Examine the PPO to differentiate between WELLBORE and RESERVOIR effects.
