To cite a journal article using APA style, you need to cover the following details of the source in the following sequence:

1st Author's 2nd Author's 3rd Author's Article's title in Publication year last name last name last name sentence-case, i.e., enclosed within followed by followed by followed by capitalize only parentheses author initials author initials author initials the first word & (round brackets) proper nouns Author, A. A., Author, B. B., & Author, C. C. (Year). Title of article. Title of Periodical, volume number(issue number), pages, http://doi.org/xx.xxx/yyyyy The title of the journal Journal or Page numbers Journal or Include DOI if or periodical in title case periodical's periodical's covered by the article you and italicized issue number the article in volume number are citing has (italicized) the journal or been assigned periodical one

SOME POINTS TO REMEMBER!

- Invert the authors' names, i.e., an author's last name should appear first followed by his/her initials, each of which must be followed by a period (.)
- If the source has only 2 authors, separate them using an ampersand (&) instead of "and"
- . The title of the article must be followed by a period
- The title of the journal or periodical must be italicized and followed by a comma (,)
- The issue number must be followed by a comma and there should be no space between it and the volume number
- Page numbers must be followed by a period
