- c. When an American buys a Japanese bond, the transaction is recorded as the U.S. financial account as a purchase of a financial asset by an American. The balance of payments on the U.S. financial account will fall.
- d. When an American charity sends a gift to Africa, it is recorded as a transfer payment to a foreigner in the U.S. current account. The balance on the U.S. current account will fall.
2. a. The two diagrams above are evidence that the United States has experienced net capital outflows. First, the price paid for the world price being sold abroad was the United States, increasing there as a percentage of U.S. GDP. In fact, between 1970 and 1976, the United States moved from running a deficit in its current account, which means that it became the supplier of more net capital inflows than the rest of the world.
- b. Yes, the diagram indicates that world economies were more tightly linked in 1976 than they were in 1970. Because the United States has more exports abroad and other countries were more likely to buy U.S. goods, "increased integration" has become a possibility. A historical price to compare is more likely to be a historical price to another country.
