Haiti Operational Plan Report Fy 2013 United States United States Department of State, 2014-11-12 For many in the United States Haiti has become synonymous with hurricanes and earthquakes whose effects are compounded by the vulnerability of the populations they strike in the Haitian countryside and the precarious hillside encampments around Port au Prince Natural disaster combined with frequent political instability and disease have continually set back Haitian efforts to chart a stable path toward social and economic renewal While there are numerous interdependent needs to break these cycles of poverty improving the health of the Haitian population is central to rebuilding the human and economic capital of one of America's closest neighbors Haiti's estimated 135 000 HIV positive individuals constitute the greatest burden of HIV AIDS care and treatment responsibility in the Caribbean region Underlying the data are geographic shifts in populations living with HIV and a need to reach key populations disproportionately affected by the virus with effective prevention programs Haiti has a generalized HIV AIDS epidemic with higher prevalence rates in major cities and driven by key populations such as commercial sex workers CSW and men who have sex with men MSM and the social conditions of women and youth As of December 2012 72 percent of HIV infected individuals with immediate need for antiretroviral therapy were receiving it and 65 percent of pregnant women were tested for HIV There is a high level of stigmatization towards HIV positive individuals in the country especially at the community level Overall communicable diseases make up a starkly higher proportion of mortality 72 percent than the regional average 20 percent Haiti has the highest rate of tuberculosis TB in the Western Hemisphere with an estimated incidence of 306 cases for 100 000 inhabitants of which about 60 percent of expected cases are detected and 60 percent of TB patients are tested for HIV Malaria prevalence is estimated at 4.9 percent More than 600 000 cases and nearly 8 000 deaths have been reported since the cholera epidemic began in Haiti The Budget of the <u>United States Government</u> United States. Office of Management and Budget, 2010 Dominican Republic Operational Plan Report Fy 2013 United States United States Department of State, 2014-11-12 The Dominican Republic DR with a population of 9 7 million 2010 census shares the Island of Hispaniola with Haiti The DR has an HIV seroprevalence of 0 8% DHS 2007 slightly lower than the 1 0% from DHS 2002 New seroprevalence estimates from the 2013 DHS should be available by the end of 2014 The epidemic is largely driven by heterosexual practices including multiple partners and transactional sex However men who have sex with men MSM transgender and male and female commercial sex workers CSW exhibit higher seroprevalence than the national level Additionally drug users DU residents of Bateyes and women with fewer than four years of formal education have higher rates than the general population UNAIDS and the Ministry of Health 2011 estimate that in 2012 nearly 44 000 persons adults and children were living with HIV and approximately 1700 deaths were attributable to AIDS Ministry of Health MOH data December 2012 indicate that 21 579 persons 20 496 adults and 1083 children are on antiretroviral ARV therapy an increase of over 2100 persons 11% since November 2011 Current data on key

frameworks OGAC concurred with this recommendation
