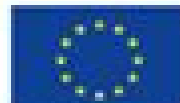

The EU's Human Rights Dialogue with China Katrin Kinzelbach, 2014-10-03 The European Union uses a confidential institutionalized Dialogue to raise human rights concerns with China but little is publicly known about its set up its substance its development over time and its impact This book provides the first detailed reconstruction and assessment of the EU s responses to human rights violations in China from 1995 to the present day Using classified documents in the EU s historical archives and interviews with diplomats officials and human rights experts in Europe China and the United States Kinzelbach lifts the veil of secrecy on the EU China Human Rights Dialogue and provides a rare insight into how the European Union and China conduct quiet diplomacy on human rights The book reconstructs the evolution of the Dialogue and the EU s internal debate on the merits of quiet diplomacy and draws comparisons with the approach of other actors notably that of the United States In doing so the EU s relative impact is concluded to be tenuous if not counter productive The book also chronicles and analyzes numerous human rights concerns that were raised in the period ranging from structural issues to individual cases This ground breaking in depth case study will be of interest to students and scholars of international politics human rights international law EU politics especially the EU s Common Foreign and Security Policy and Chinese politics

mechanisms of implementation this volume provides a multidimensional overview of human rights After examining briefly the history of human rights the author analyses the intellectual framework that forms the basis of their legitimacy In particular he covers the concept of universality and the widely used model that classifies human rights into clusters of different generations In this edition the author brings together the fundamental aspects of human rights law addressing human dignity as the ethical foundation of human rights the principle of equality and non discrimination as the essence of any culture of human rights the protections against racial discrimination and discrimination against women and assesses the individual as a subject of international law The volume then moves on to assess the activities of the political institutions of the United Nations the expert bodies established by the relevant treaties and the international tribunals specifically entrusted at the regional level with protecting human rights This edition also includes specific analysis of the actions mandated by the UN Security Council against Libya in 2011 It also includes greater coverage of the jurisprudence of the Inter American Court of Human Rights and the African Commission on Human and Peoples Rights The author explains how and why the classical array of politically inspired informal devices has been enriched by the addition of international criminal procedures and by endeavours to introduce civil suits against alleged individual violators of human rights Finally the volume is rounded off by a consideration of the importance of humanitarian law as an instrument for the protection of human life and dignity and an exploration of the future of human rights

and Human Rights Democracies need to understand these terms to properly adapt their legal frameworks Regulation of hate speech exposes underlining and sometimes invisible societal values such as security and public order equality and non discrimination human dignity and other democratic vital interests The spread of hatred and hate speech has intensified in many corners of the world over the last decade and its regulation presents a conundrum for many democracies This book presents a three prong theory describing three different but complementary models of hate speech regulation which allows stakeholders to better address this phenomenon It examines international and national legal frameworks and related case law as well as pertinent scholarly literature review to highlight this development After a period of an absence of free speech during communism post communist democracies have sought to build a framework for the exercise of free speech while protecting public goods such as liberty equality and human dignity The three prong theory is applied to identify public goods and values underlining the regulation of hate speech in the Czech Republic and Slovakia two countries that share a political sociological and legal history as an example of the differing approaches to hate speech regulation in post communist societies due to divergent social values despite identical legal frameworks This book will be of great interest to scholars of human rights law lawyers judges government NGOs media and anyone who would like to understand values that underpin hate speech regulations which reflect values that society cherishes the most

Importing EU Norms Annika Björkdahl, Natalia Chaban, John Leslie, Annick Masselot, 2015-03-20 This interdisciplinary work presents a conceptual framework and brings together constructivist and rationalist accounts of how EU norms are adopted adapted resisted or rejected These chapters provide empirical cases and critical analysis of a rich variety of norm takers from EU member states European and non European states including the rejection of EU norms in Russia and Africa as well as adaptation of EU practices in Australia and New Zealand Chapters on China ASEAN and the Czech Republic demonstrate resistance to EU norm export This volume probes differences in willingness to adopt or adapt norms between various actors in the recipient state and explores such questions as How do norm takers perceive of the EU and its norms Is there a normative fit between EU norms and the local normative context Similarly how do EU norms impact recipients interests and institutional arrangements First the authors map EU norm export strategies and approaches as they affect norm takers Second the chapters recognize that norm adoption adaption resistance or rejection is a product of interaction and a relationship in which interdependence asymmetry and power play a role Third we see that domestic circumstances within norm takers condition the reception of norms This book s focus on norm takers highlights the reflexive nature of norm diffusion and that nature has implications for the EU itself as a norm exporter Anyone with an interest in the research agenda on norm diffusion normative power and the EU s normative dialogue with the world will find this book highly valuable including scholars policy makers and students of subjects including political science European studies international relations and international and EU law

The EU Anti-Corruption Report Andi Hoxhaj, 2019-10-16 This book analyses the development of anti corruption as a policy field in

the European Union with a particular focus on the EU Anti Corruption Report It reconstructs the origins of anti corruption policy in the 1990s when the EU started to recognise corruption as a serious crime with a cross border dimension It also analyses the processes surrounding the downfall of the Santer Commission on charges of corruption in 1999 and the enlargement of the EU This incorporation of transitional new Member States was accompanied by a number of specific measures instruments and monitoring mechanisms to combat corruption at the supranational level finally leading to the introduction of the EU wide Anti Corruption Report in 2014 The book presents an in depth analysis of its implementation abandonment and the way forward under the European Semester as the new instrument for achieving EU anti corruption reforms It offers a new interpretation of the Report as a form of reflexive governance that operates at multiple levels and involves not only the European institutions and national governments but also the role of civil society actors in the process of developing anti corruption policy It applies the theory of reflexive governance in analysing the impact of the Report in the UK Romania and Albania including the involvement of non state actors in anti corruption policy making in these countries The book concludes with a discussion on how future EU Anti Corruption policy can make use of reflexive governance and offers recommendations to enhance anti corruption policies of the EU the Member States and Candidate States

Europe and China Roland Vogt, 2012-03-01 This edited volume analyzes the changing nature of the relationship between China and Europe This relationship has been subject to significant shifts and transformations not least because of the enormity of China's social and economic development since 1978 and the political consequences this has brought about in international politics The global financial crisis of 2008-09 and the subsequent sovereign debt emergency in Europe have also altered the nature of the interactions between the two regions China has become a more assertive confident and active player on the global stage Its economic development is now a major pillar of the global economy and its growth has been conducive for a fragile economic recovery to take place in Europe and beyond

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
