Siracusa, Hang Thi Thuy Nguyen, 2018-04-13 This book re examines the Nixon administration s attitude and approach to the European integration project The formulation of US policy towards European integration in the Nixon presidential years 1969 1974 was conditioned by the perceived relative decline of the United States Western European emergence and competition the feared Communist expansionism and US national interests Against that backdrop the Nixon administration saw the need to re evaluate its policy on Western Europe and the integration process on this continent Underpinning this study is the extensive use of newly released archival materials from the Nixon Presidential Library and Museum the Library of Congress and the State Department Furthermore the work is based on the public papers in the American Presidency Project and the materials on the topic of European integration and unification in the Archive of European Integration Finally the study has extensively used newspaper archives as well as the declassified online documents memoirs and diaries of former US officials Mining these sources made it possible to shed new light on the complexity and dynamism of the Nixon administration s policy towards European integration

The Lost Promise Ellen Schrecker, 2024-05-31 The Lost Promise is a magisterial examination of the turmoil that rocked American universities in the 1960s with a unique focus on the complex roles played by professors as well as students The 1950s through the early 1970s are widely seen as American academia s golden age when universities well funded and viewed as essential for national security economic growth and social mobility embraced an egalitarian mission Swelling in size schools attracted new types of students and professors including radicals who challenged their institutions

calcified traditions But that halcyon moment soon came to a painful and confusing end with consequences that still afflict the halls of ivy In *The Lost Promise* Ellen Schrecker our foremost historian of both the McCarthy era and the modern American university delivers a far reaching examination of how and why it happened Schrecker illuminates how US universities explosive growth intersected with the turmoil of the 1960s fomenting an unprecedented crisis where dissent over racial inequality and the Vietnam War erupted into direct action Torn by internal power struggles and demonized by conservative voices higher education never fully recovered resulting in decades of underfunding and today's woefully inequitable system As Schrecker's magisterial history makes blazingly clear the complex blend of troubles that disrupted the university in that pivotal period haunts the ivory tower to this day

A World History of War Crimes Michael S. Bryant, 2015-12-17 A World History of War Crimes provides a truly global history of war crimes and the involvement of the legal systems faced with these acts Documenting the long historical arc traced by human efforts to limit warfare from codes of war in antiquity designed to maintain a religiously conceived cosmic order to the gradual use in the modern age of the criminal trial as a means of enforcing universal norms this book provides a comprehensive one volume account of war and the laws that have governed conflict since the dawn of world civilizations Throughout his narrative Michael Bryant locates the origin and evolution of the law of war in the interplay between different cultures While showing that no single philosophical idea underlay the law of war in world history this volume also proves that war in global civilization has rarely been an anarchic free for all Rather from its beginnings warfare has been subject to certain constraints defined by the unique needs and cosmological understandings of the cultures that produce them Only in late modernity has law assumed its current international humanitarian form The criminalization of war crimes in international courts today is only the most recent development of the ancient theme of constraining when and how war may be fought

Crimea, Global Rivalry, and the Vengeance of History Hall Gardner, 2016-04-30 Gardner examines the causes and consequences of Russia's annexation of Crimea By analyzing alliance formations and the consequences of other annexations in world history the book urges an alternative US NATO European Japanese strategy toward both Russia and China in the effort to prevent a renewed arms race if not global war

The History of Oxford University Press: Volume IV Keith Robbins, 2017-05-26 The story of Oxford University Press spans five centuries of printing and publishing Beginning with the first presses set up in Oxford in the fifteenth century and the later establishment of a university printing house it leads through the publication of bibles scholarly works and the Oxford English Dictionary to a twentieth century expansion that created the largest university press in the world playing a part in research education and language learning in more than 50 countries With access to extensive archives the four volume History of OUP traces the impact of long term changes in printing technology and the business of publishing It also considers the effects of wider trends in education reading and scholarship in international trade and the spreading influence of the English language and in cultural and social history both in Oxford and through its presence around the world In the decades

after 1970 Oxford University Press met new challenges but also a period of unprecedented growth In this concluding volume Keith Robbins and 21 expert contributors assess OUP's changing structure its academic mission and its business operations through years of economic turbulence and continuous technological change The Press repositioned itself after 1970 it brought its London Business to Oxford closed its Printing House and rapidly developed new publishing for English language teaching in regions far beyond its traditional markets Yet in an increasingly competitive worldwide industry OUP remained the department of a major British university sharing its commitment to excellence in scholarship and education The resulting opportunities and sometimes tensions are traced here through detailed consideration of OUP's business decisions the vast range of its publications and the dynamic role of its overseas offices Concluding in 2004 with new forms of digital publishing The History of OUP sheds new light on the cultural educational and business life of the English speaking world in the late twentieth century

Who Owns History? Geoffrey Robertson, 2019-11-05 The biggest question in the world of art and culture concerns the return of property taken without consent Throughout history conquerors or colonial masters have taken artefacts from subjugated peoples who now want them returned from museums and private collections in Europe and the USA The controversy rages on over the Elgin Marbles and has been given immediacy by figures such as France's President Macron who says he will order French museums to return hundreds of artworks acquired by force or fraud in Africa and by British opposition leader Jeremy Corbyn who has pledged that a Labour government would return the Elgin Marbles to Greece Elsewhere there is a debate in Belgium about whether the Africa Museum newly opened with 120 000 items acquired mainly by armed forces in the Congo should close Although there is an international convention dated 1970 that deals with the restoration of artefacts stolen since that time there is no agreement on the rules of law or ethics which should govern the fate of objects forcefully or lawlessly acquired in previous centuries Who Owns History delves into the crucial debate over the Elgin Marbles but also offers a system for the return of cultural property based on human rights law principles that are being developed by the courts It is not a legal text but rather an examination of how the past can be experienced by everyone as well as by the people of the country of origin

House, 2020-09-24 Study of the Cold War all too often shows us the war that wasn't fought The reality of course is that many hot conflicts did occur some with the great powers weapons and approval others without It is this reality and this period of quasi war and semiconflict that Jonathan M House plumbs in *A Military History of the Cold War 1962-1991* a complex case study in the Clausewitzian relationship between policy and military force during a time of global upheaval and political realignment This volume opens a new perspective on three fraught decades of Cold War history revealing how the realities of time distance resources and military culture often constrained and diverted the inclinations or policies of world leaders In addition to the Vietnam War and nuclear confrontations between the USSR and the United States this period saw dozens of regional wars and insurgencies fought throughout Asia Africa and Latin America Cuba Pakistan Indonesia Israel Egypt and South Africa pursued their own goals in ways that drew the superpowers into regional disputes Even clashes ostensibly unrelated to the politics of East West confrontation such as the Nigerian Biafran conflict the Falklands Malvinas War and the Indonesian occupation of East Timor involved armed forces weapons and tactics developed for the larger conflict and thus come under House's scrutiny His study also takes up nontraditional or specialized aspects of the period including weapons of mass destruction civil military relations civil defense and control of domestic disorders The result is a single integrated survey and analysis of a complex period in geopolitical history which fills a significant gap in our knowledge of the organization logistics operations and tactics involved in conflict throughout the Cold War
