Minerals are very interesting and are lots of fun to learn 11 about. They are a solid and have never been alive. Minerals 22 were formed in nature. We identify or name minerals by their 33 properties. One property that we look at is how hard a 444 mineral is. When we test or measure a mineral's hardness 5.4 that is called a scratch test. The hardest mineral is a 65 diamond, and the softest mineral is talc. We use a streak 76 test to help identify minerals. In a streak test, we rub a SIS mineral on an unglazed, white tile and see what color streak 99 it leaves behind. Luster is the reflection of light from a 110 mineral. Minerals with a lot of luster look shiny. Sometimes 120 minerals are the same color, which is why we often cannot 131 use color to identify minerals. 136
