### Requirements:

  - **Board must be original**, not one taken from a previously owned board game.
- Game theme, questions, statements, layout, design must be related to Greek mythology legend and concepts
- Rules: The rules must be written out, understandable, and applicable to the game you created
- Directions: how to play the game
- A minimum of 25 spaces (start, end, move-forward/backward two spaces, etc.)
- Neat and organized
- Creative, colorful and pretty! Who wants to play a game with no character?
- Your board game must be playable- you will play each other's games later this week.
