

Clarity

Clarity Refers to the presence of inclusions in a diamond, inclusions are natural identifying characteristics such as minerals or fractures, appearing while diamonds are formed deep beneath the earth's crust. They may look like tiny crystals, clouds or feathers. The clarity scale, ranging from F (Flawless) to Included (I), is based on the visibility of inclusions at a magnification of 10x.



The classification of body color of diamonds Extends from D (colorless) to Z (light yellow or brown) . Color grades are determined by comparing each diamond to a master set. Each letter grade represents a range of color and is a measure of how noticeable a color is.

Diamonds can be cut in various shapes (e.g. square, pear or heart). The round brilliant is probably the best known shape.












Fire, brilliancy and scintillation of a diamond are largely. determined by the proportions of various parts of the stone. Finish grade mainly ervaluates the symmetry.
