 particles called atoms, that all atoms of a given element have the same mass and
 other properties, and that atoms combine in simple, whole number ratios to form
 compounds
- solid: a state of matter in which atoms or molecules are packed close to one another in fixed locations with definite volume
- liquid: a state of matter in which atoms or molecules pack about as close as they
 do in solid matter but are free to move relative to one another; liquids have a fixed
 volume but not a fixed shape
