0.07276 mol C₃H₁₂ x $\frac{5 \, mol \, C \, O_2}{1 \, mol \, C_5 \, H_{12}} = 0.3638 \, mol \, CO_2$
0.3638 mol CO₂ x $\frac{44.009 \, g \, CO_2}{1 \, mol \, CO_2} = 16.0 \, g \, CO_2$

 If 9.75 grams of oxygen (O₂) are completely reacted with pentane (C₅H₁₂), how many grams of carbon dioxide (CO₂) will be produced?

9.75 g O₂ x
$$\frac{1 mol O_2}{31.998 g O_2}$$
 = 0.3047 mol O₂
0.3047 mol O₂ x $\frac{5 mol C O_2}{8 mol O_2}$ = 0.1904 mol CO₂
0.1904 mol CO₂ x $\frac{44.009 g CO_2}{1 mol CO_2}$ = 8.38 g CO₂
